## **Hereworth Camps**

An exciting new line up of camps is currently in the process of being designed for Hereworth boys.

We believe the new camps from Years 5-8 will be both exciting and challenging learning experiences for the boys. The camp programmes will be run by qualified professionals who will be dedicated to meeting our educational and safety requirements.

The camps are being designed as a progression to build on previous experiences. While the new cost of the Years 5 and 6 camps has reduced, the cost of the senior camps will, unfortunately, increase. These increased costs are necessary to ensure we continue to provide a quality and safe EOTC (Education Outside the Classroom) experience for the boys. A full programme and final cost for your son's camp will be provided early in Term 4.

Year 5: Guthrie Smith Centre Tutira, October 12-14 Term Four 2016  
Approximate Cost \$150

Year 6: Guthrie Smith Centre Tutira, February 8-10 Term One 2017  
Approximate Cost \$200 - \$250

Year 7: Makahika Outdoor Pursuits Centre, February 7-10 Term One 2017  
Approximate Cost \$380 - \$400

Year 8: Hillary Outdoors Education Centre Tongariro, February 6-10 Term One 2017  
Approximate Cost \$600

Please note: The Years 6-8 camps are all in the second week of Term one 2017 and the Year 8 camp will actually depart on the afternoon of Waitangi Day.
